Please share your favorite recipe (or two) for inclusion in a SFCC recipe book!

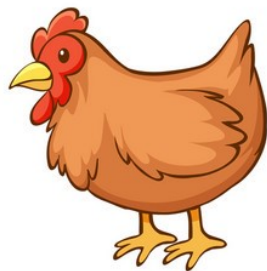


Recipe books will be available at the annual SFCC Street Fair in November (people can also pre-order if they prefer). Quantities will be limited.

ACREAGE SYSTEM ELECTION OF NEW SBFID DIRECTOR ON NOVEMBER 9, 2021

As a homeowner in Sunburst Farms Irrigation District, you have right to vote for the director who will serve on the board and make decisions for the next 3 years. Need to elect someone who will be representing ALL the 647 homeowners and 828 acres in our district.

In the Acreage system of voting (one vote for each acre), homeowners are qualified to vote if they are: residents of the state of Arizona, are at least 18 years old and have owned the property in the Sunburst Farms District for at least 90 days before the election.

INDIVIDUAL – JOINT – COMMUNITY PROPERTY, ETC. | All homeowners who own their property as individuals, (such as, individual, joint tenants, community property, etc.), do not need to register to be qualified to vote in the next election. You are already qualified and can vote in the next election. If more than one person is listed on the title, then each person can vote based on the fraction of ownership.

TRUST | All properties that are owned by a Trust requires that ALL trustee(s) fill out a form to declare which individual has the authority to cast the vote(s) for those properties. One person will have the authority to cast all the votes.

CORPORATIONS | All properties in SBFID that are owned by a Corporation requires that the board members of that corporation pass a resolution appointing an authorized person to cast the votes for the properties. That resolution must be submitted to SBFID no later than 30 days prior to the election. (30 days prior to the election is the LAST day that corporate resolutions can be submitted to SBFID).

EARLY BALLOT | You have the right to ask that an early ballot be sent to you at your residence. (93 days before the election is the earliest and 15 days prior to election is the latest date you can request an Early/Absentee ballot).

A. Call of Election per A.R.S. 16-227 A.

1. Purpose of the Election: Acreage System Election of one Board Member
2. Date of Election: November 9, 2021
3. The last date for filing nomination petitions:
 - a. To have Candidate's name on the ballot: The last date to file nomination petition is July 12, 2021
 - b. To have a qualified candidate be a valid write-in candidate for an election that may be canceled: August 25, 2021.
 - c. To submit petition to have a qualified candidate be a valid write-in candidate is 10 days prior to election: October 29, 2021.
4. The last date for corporations to submit an authorized resolution designating the person to vote in the Election is October 8, 2021.
5. Sunburst Farms Irrigation District will conduct the Election at the District Office located at 16040 N. 43rd Ave., Glendale, AZ 85306 Polls will be open: 8AM to 6PM.

Voter Qualifications: Holder of evidence of title for at least 90 days prior to election. Must have resided continuously for six (6) months immediately preceding the Election in the County in which the District or a part thereof is located. Must be at least 18 years of age.

Safety Tips: Benefits of Engraving Property

- Engrave property with your driver's license number.
- Make sure to put AZDL in front so if it is recovered out of Arizona, it can be returned.
- Engravers work on plastic, metal and wood.
- Items worth engraving include bicycles, electronic equipment and tools.
- Make an inventory list of engraved property items and keep it in a safe place.
- Once you have marked the property, put decals

on your front and rear doors or windows alerting would be criminals that your property is marked for identification.

- Take photos or video of other valuable property.

Engraving provides evidence of guilt and enables police to detain a suspect who is found in possession of property engraved with someone else's driver's license number. Engraving also serves as a deterrent as criminals are less likely to steal marked property. Plus there is a higher likelihood that the property will be returned to its rightful owner.
